STRUCTURE OF ASSESSMENT 2022-23

CBSE CURRICULUM envisages individual learning propensity and seeks to explore the potential of students in acquiring knowledge and skills. Experiential and active learning promote critical thinking, creativity and effective study skills among students.

The Assessment scheme will have 20 marks component of internal assessment and 80 marks component of annual examination. One time year-end examination is complimented and supplemented with internal assessment that assesses students in diverse manner at different times. The components of internal assessment is as follows:

(1) Periodic Assessment (05 marks)

The main purpose of periodic assessment is to assess the learning progress of students. Assessment done at regular intervals provides feedback and insight to teachers regarding learners' needs and helps them to improve instruction, do remedial teaching and set curricular targets for students.

(2) Multiple Assessment (05 marks)

Multiple assessment strategies relevant to particular learning outcomes are achieved over the period of curriculum transaction. Teachers have the flexibility to use multiple and diverse techniques to assess learners like observation, oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, field work, concept maps, graphic organizers, visual representation, demonstration, quizzes etc.

(3) Portfolio (05 marks)

Portfolio holds the performance records and documents. It includes class work and home work assignments, key words, theme, summarisation and organisation of ideas, photos, presentations, art integrated learning work, achievements etc.

(4) Subject Enrichment Activities (05 marks)

It's important that the subject enrichment activities be conducted rigorously and with complete focus. In languages, excerpts are used from relevant suitable literature and to develop vocabulary, listening and speaking activities are arranged. Lab experiments are focused in Science and Mathematics to generate hypothesis, innovation and finding solutions. Projects related to Art and culture, Life skills are encouraged in Social Science.

• Assessment of Art Education and Health and Physical education are continuously done by collecting information and using that information to review children's progress and to plan future learning experiences. These activities will be graded on 5- point grading scale (A to E) and will have no descriptive indicators. Children's participation in activities/ competitions organised and conducted throughout the academic year form the basis of assessing the students in Art Education. Health and Physical Activities preferably sports and competitions are recorded to assess children.

• Value Education is also included in the Assessment scheme. Hygiene, sanitation, dedication, honesty, truthfulness, kindness, empathy, respect for environment, elders and all living things etc are the values that our students must actively practice. Class teacher will grade the students on a 5 point scale (A to E) keeping in view the overall attendance, sincerity, values and behaviour of the students.

Students are able to think scientifically, mathematically or artistically to face the real challenges in an information and technology driven world and enhance their inherent potential.

A Class was conducted with the discussion on qualities to be shaped among teachers. According to Sir, Teachers should be influencial and capable trainers for students. A teacher can identify the strengths of a child. Sir explained about the symptoms of leprosy. General symptom of leprosy is light coloured or red patches with reduced sensation. The growth of bacteria is very slow. Teachers should impart the knowledge to parents. If we observe any light coloured patches on a child 's body, then we can press on that area with the tip of pen. If there is no sensation to the child, the matter should be shared with parents. It is cured by using the medicine MDT in the initial stage. If it is not paid attention, it will affect the nervous system. Each class teacher should confirm whether any child is having such type of patches on their body or not. The screening report of each class should be sent before 26 th October through mail. Photos of oath taking by students should also be sent.
